The Honorable John Quincy Adams, the sixth President of the United States, was selected as the Orator on this interesting occasion; and letters of invitation were addressed to distinguished survivors of the Revolutionary period, to the Historical Societies of other states, and to various public functionaries, requesting their attendance. Mh. Adams, having accepted the appointment, arrived in town from Washington on Monday, April 29th, and in the evening met a large number of the members of the Society at their rooms in the...
